The Federal Transit Administration (FTA) has completed its review of the Regional Transportation District (RTD) proposal and supporting documentation to change the location of the Federal Station on the Gold Line project. FTA finds there is no significant environmental impact to the change in location of the Gold Line Federal Station, and will not require a supplemental Environmental Impact Statement pursuant to 23 CFR § 771.130(c).

Please continue to keep us informed of potential changes to the Gold Line or East Corridor projects, so that FTA can determine if additional environmental documentation will be required to incorporate changes into the project definitions.
